2. Minutes of the 2017 AGM

The Minutes of the 2017 AGM had been distributed before the meeting. There were no corrections.

3. Secretary's Report

A correction was made to the report. The 02/06/18 event was held at Cassiobury not Highfield, using the course from the earlier cancelled event. The Organiser was Tim Gage not Mike Bennett.

Heather Bayne outlined the highlights of the report, which were available at the meeting and had been electronically distributed prior to the meeting. *Report accepted*.

4. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report was available at the meeting and had been electronically distributed prior to the meeting. As Hugh Wiltshire was unable to attend the AGM it had been requested that any questions on the report be emailed to him in advance, so that the AGM could be provided with Hugh's response.

After the amendments to the pricing of the Saturday Series the accounts are now showing them as breaking even over a full year. There is a balance between membership fees paying for membership related expenditure.

Q: Has the Committee looked at the issue of differential pricing of SS to encourage early registration?

The committee feels that this is possible when we are collecting payment prior to an event, however when payment is on the day, differential pricing just complicates the process too much for the volunteers on the Registration desk.

Q: Has there been any consideration of paying by credit card? The incoming committee was recommended to consider this as the technology has become easier to use. It might also help with the issue of insufficient change at events.

The Committee proposed to keep the HH element of the membership fee the same as last year. However the BOF element is rising so the total membership fee will rise slightly.

Q: Will Half fees be given again next year? If you join after June we presently ask a half year fee. Continuation of this arrangement was agreed.

Q: How do our fees compare with neighbouring clubs? This is difficult due to the way in which different Regions take their funding element. HH is not an outlier. Compared to other sports clubs in Herts HH is very low.

The meeting thanked Hugh for the considerable amount of work put into reorganizing the accounts into the new format.
