The Treasurer presented his report and financial accounts (sent to all club members on the Groups.io mailing list and published on the club website). He explained the items where there were significant differences from the previous year.

Overall, the Club delivered a substantial surplus, mostly due to the Ace of Herts, Jack of Herts and Yvette Baker Trophy events. The Saturday Series events and Street-O continued to operate close to overall break-even (though with significant variation between individual events).

The accounts have been independently examined, by the Honorary Auditor/Examiner, Roger Moulding who believes that they give a true and fair view of the club's financial affairs.

The 2024-25 accounts were proposed to be accepted. This was carried without dissent.

In view of the surplus and the healthy bank balances, the Treasurer proposed to keep the Club membership fees the same for next year as they were this year. This was accepted by the AGM. These Club membership fees are:
